

2015 ILLINOIS ECE CREDENTIAL ALIGNMENT SUPPORT PROJECT FOR GATEWAYS ENTITLED TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

PROJECT CONTEXT

In August 2015, the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) approved changes to the Gateways ECE Credential requirements. Gateways entitled institutions will be required to meet these changes by July 1, 2016. These changes create an opportunity to better support candidates and working professionals in completing certificates and degrees that are aligned to recognized credentials.

The Illinois Community College Board (ICCB), in partnership with the Governor's Office of Early Childhood Development (OECD), the Illinois Network of Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies (INCCRRA), the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS), and the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE), seek applications from two year institutions for financial and technical support to align early childhood programs with the Gateways ECE Credential Levels and in doing so improve the stackability of certificates and degrees offered. The funds for this project are federal dollars through the Race to the Top Early Learning Challenge, administered by INCCRRA, and available for disbursement by INCCRRA to applicants selected to participate in the project.

PROJECT SCOPE

The primary goal of this project is to create a transparent, seamless educational pathway for candidates and working professionals to complete aligned certificates, degrees and credentials. This project will provide up to \$3,000.00 in financial support for faculty stipend or release for this work. This work will take place between Fall 2015 and June 2016 and will include:

- collaborating with the Technical Assistance Team,
- analyzing degrees and certificates for alignment,
- evaluating program marketing and advisement materials to promote pathway transparency,
- making needed revisions, and
- participating in regional meetings.

INSTITUTION ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be two-year public and private institutions offering ECE degrees and certificates. Applicants must be ECE Gateways entitled institutions. Only one application per institution will be accepted.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION/PROJECT TIMELINE

Applications will be due 10/21/15. Participants will be notified of acceptance by 10/30/15 and work will begin on or around 11/2/15.
